The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 25.06.2022 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 30.11.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Dilbagh Singh, PPS, DSP Operations District Ludhiana (Rural) Add. Charge as DSP, Dakha, District Ludhiana and the same is taken on record. He submits on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 04.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
