Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to the State to conduct reinvestigation in FIR No.132 dated 17.07.2021 registered under Sections 354-D, 376(2) (n), 506 and 509 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the State has conducted investigation in the FIR in question and finding the contents thereof to be false has prepared a report seeking cancellation thereof. It is further submitted that such report shall be presented before the competent Court within two weeks but only after due intimation to the petitioner and this is so because on an earlier occasion when the cancellation report was

filed before the competent Court the petitioner failed to appear before the Court to file her protest petition.

In the light of the afore statement, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the issues taken in the present petition before the competent Court where the State would be filing the cancellation report.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
