[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 30.06.2021 in CWP No.9813 of 2021, the respondent has passed speaking order dated 21.10.2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge said speaking order by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the orders dated 30.06.2021 in CWP No.9813 of 2021 having been complied with as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

[4] Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge speaking order dated 21.10.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
