Case has been called twice. No one is present on behalf of the appellant. On 18.01.2022 and 10.02.2022 also, none was present on behalf of the appellant.

Prior to that on 06.12.2021, the following facts were recorded:-

“It has been brought to the notice of the Court that reply was filed by the State but it has not been placed on record and a wrong certificate has been given that all the documents of the civil writ petition have been appended. Reference is made to the rejoinder filed on behalf of the petitioner (Annexure P-9) in support of the said submission.

Let records of CWP No. 2500 of 2020 be attached with the present appeal.

Adjourned to 17.01.2022.”

A perusal of the record of **CWP-2500-2020** would show that

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the reply was duly filed, by respondents No.1 to 3.

Certificate given by the counsel for the appellant in support the appeal reads as under:-

“Certificate

Certified that the complete paper book of Civil Writ Petition along with annexures and list of dates and events have been attached with this appeal. The Civil Writ Petition was dismissed in limini on 20.08.2021.”

Keeping in view the above concealment as such, this Court is of the opinion that the appeal is not liable to heard on merits as per the settled principle laid down by the Hon’ble Apex Court in **M/s Prestige Lights Ltd. Vs. State Bank of India, 2007 (4) R.C.R. (Civil) 46.**

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed on the ground of concealment.
