Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had competed for appointment in various categories in respect to the advertisement No. 12 of 2019 dated 20.07.2019 and the petitioner had appeared in the written examination in all the categories in which the petitioner had applied for and now, the respondents have declared the result of the written examination and sought objections from the candidate concerned.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner further submits that till the response sheet and the correct answer key of the question in respect of each category in which the petitioner is competing, is supplied to the

petitioner, the petitioner is not in a position to submit his objections.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already approached the respondents under the RTI Act also claiming the copy of the response sheet along with the answer key but the response sheet as well as answer key have not been supplied.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Dikansh Goyal, Law Officer, HSSC, submits that out of the 13 categories in which the petitioner is claiming the submission of the response sheet along with the answer key, in eight categories the said information will be sent to the petitioner to be downloaded via link, which link will be sent on his registered mobile number as filled in the application form and in the remaining categories, the similar link for downloading the response sheet as well as the answer key will be sent by 17.08.2022.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case, the undertaking is not complied with by the respondents.

Ordered accordingly.
