Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the prayer of the petitioner for the grant of benefit under Rule 4.2-A of the Civil Services Rules has been rejected on the ground that the petitioner is not eligible for the same as the petitioner does not have qualifying service for the grant of pension, but as per the petitioner there is a provision to grant the benefit of two years' service in certain circumstances so as to complete 10 years service, therefore, the petitioner be allowed to withdraw this petition at this stage with liberty to approach the respondents with the said plea.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner making out a claim for the grant of

benefit, the same will be considered as per law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
