Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing the impugned orders dated 31.08.2016 (P-13 & P-14), vide which extension in service granted to the petitioner on 20.04.2016 (P-12) was curtailed, while relieving her from service on the ground of involving in FIR No. 190, dated 24.09.2014, under Sections 406/498-A/323 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No. 1, Jalandhar.
