Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is working as a Junior Assistant, has been transferred from Patiala to Ludhiana. She has a six years old school going daughter, who is studying in class-III at Patiala, and other family members are staying at Patiala and, therefore, it would be difficult for her to travel from Patiala to Ludhiana. He also submits that she has sent a representation (Annexure P5) in this regard to respondent No. 2 on 22.07.2022, but no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that respondent No. 2 may be directed to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P5).

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

The petitioner is a lady with a minor daughter. She has sent a

representation (Annexure P5) to respondent No. 2. Therefore, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide her representation (Annexure P5) and pass an order within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Till the representation (Annexure P5) is decided, the petitioner shall be permitted to continue to work at Patiala.
