AMARJOT BHATTI J. (ORAL)

The petitioner-Vikram Singh has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing FIR No.0224 dated 31.05.2021, registered under Sections 354, 354-A and 506 of IPC at Police Station Sector 50, District Gurugram and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise between the parties.

As per the facts of the case, one complaint was received for sexual exploitation and the threats given to her, against Vikram Singh and Gaurav Sandilay. The complainant-Renuka stated that she was working as Assistant Manager in the company, which is in IT Park appointed by Vikram Singh at a salary of Rs.30,000/- per month. She

was working in the office as well as at home. She was not given other benefits as Vikram Singh was compelling her to maintain physical relations with him. The matter was brought to the notice of Company's Women Protection Cell but no action was taken. She was given a letter by the company that her work was not proper. She was being harassed due to the conduct of Vikram Singh but no legal action was taken. Ultimately, she filed the present complaint.

The petitioner filed this petition for the quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. The petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. The detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gurugram dated 30.08.2022. The statement of complainant-Renuka has been recorded, where she confirmed the compromise with the petitioner. She confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and she has no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

The petitioner-Vikram Singh also confirmed this fact in his separate statement. The statement of ASI Shastar Kumar is also recorded who further confirmed that the accused is neither involved in any other case nor has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gurugram, it is clear that the compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. They have mutually settled all their disputes. Therefore, no purpose would be served with the continuation

of criminal proceedings.

Therefore considering these facts the petition filed by the petitioner is accepted and FIR No.0224 dated 31.05.2021, registered under Sections 354, 354-A and 506 of IPC at Police Station Sector 50, District Gurugram and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
