Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to hold fresh examination for the post of Clerk, as the petitioner was not permitted to attempt full question paper and left 10 to 12 questions, due to shortage of time. Grievance arises out of non grant of additional time as per guidelines for conducting written examinations for Persons with Disabilities issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, New Delhi, same being applicable in State of Haryana.

Result of the petitioner was brought in the Court on 14.07.2022 and was marked as Annexure 'A'. Perusal of the same reveals that petitioner secured aggregate of 113 marks (96 marks in written examination and 17 marks for interview).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that in view of aforesaid and short reply dated 18.11.2018 filed by respondent No.2, he seeks to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
