Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the lower Court for deciding the bail application expeditiously if possible on same day in the case bearing FIR No.51 dated 29.10.2010, under Sections 376/452/506/120-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was 13 years old at the time of occurrence and has been falsely implicated. It has not been disputed that the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender.

In these set of circumstances, no such indulgence can be granted to issue any such direction to the learned trial Court particularly when the petitioner is yet to surrender in the Court below.

Suffice is to say that the appropriate directions for expeditious disposal of the bail application have already been issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in CrI. Appeal No. 509/2017 titled as Hussain Versus Union of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
