The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0105 dated 11.7.2021 registered under Section 498-A IPC (Section 406 IPC was added later on) at Police Station, Nangal, District Rupnagar.

By virtue of the order dated 10.9.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has however opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
