Case is taken up on board since CWP No.24469 of 2021 was ordered to be heard with this case, in which actual date of hearing was given.

Mr. Pandit submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, in view of the fact that benefit of promotion has been granted to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer. He referred to the order of the Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala dated 29.09.2017 (Annexure R-1/A) attached with the affidavit of Mohammad Tayyab, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala dated 30.11.2017. He has further pointed out that the petitioner has also retired.

A perusal of Annexure R-1/A would go on to show that the promotion was granted on the post of Senior Scale Stenographer w.e.f September, 2012 on the basis of seniority in the pay scale of 10300-34800 +4400, subject to the order which may be passed by this Court in

CWP No.1248 of 2014 ‘Saroj Bala and others Vs. State of Punjab and

It is brought to our notice that even the said case has been decided in favour of the employees, vide order dated 06.10.2018.

Resultantly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
