Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0047 dated 17.09.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A o IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 15.12.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more

required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 15.12.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
