Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to respondent No.4 not to unnecessarily harass and humiliate the petitioner by calling him to the police station time and again without complying with the provisions of Section 160 of Cr.P.C.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has nothing to do with the matrimonial dispute which is going on between Manvir Kaur and her husband Harpreet Singh (respondent No.5). He further submits that the petitioner is being unnecessarily harassed by the police just on the ground that he is friend of father of aforesaid Manvir Kaur.

Present petition is hereby disposed of without commenting on the merits of the case, with direction to respondent No.4 to comply with provisions of Section 160 and 141 of Cr.P.C. in case the petitioner is required by the police for recording of his statement in the aforesaid matrimonial dispute which is going on between Manvir Kaur and her husband Harpreet Singh (respondent No.5).
