Respondent No.5 had filed an application for restoration of a demolished watercourse. The same was allowed and appeal and revision against the said order have been dismissed. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the orders impugned are illegal as they have failed to consider the fact that petitioner has not been heard while passing the orders. Restoration has been ordered through the land of the petitioner and thus, she was a necessary party.

A perusal of the orders passed by the Courts below shows that against the order of restoration, the husband of the petitioner had filed an appeal but without success. Thereafter, the petitioner filed a revision petition which was also dismissed. In neither of these petitions a ground was taken that the petitioner was not made a party and not heard while passing the order of restoration and thus, the petitioner cannot take this ground in the writ Court for the first time.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
