This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 49 dated 26.2.2018, under Sections 341, 307, 323, 427, 186, 353, 506, 148, 149 and 34 IPC and Section 3 and 4 of the Punjab Prevention of Damage to Public and Private Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Samrala, Ludhiana.

After arguing for some time and realising that the present petition is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Manish Jain v. Haryana State Pollution Control Board, 2021(1) AICLR 416**, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

However, a request is made that the petitioners would surrender before the court within ten days and apply for regular bail, their application be taken up expeditiously.

Dismissed as not pressed. In case the petitioners surrender

within ten days and apply for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
