Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.242 dated 04.10.2021 under Sections 21-B, 29 NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

The brief facts of the case are that the petitioner was nominated as an accused on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused Naseem from whom 7 grams of heroin was recovered by the police on 4.10.2021.

The counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police

by virtue of order of interim bail dated 05.08.2022 passed by this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from SI Krishan Lal has not disputed the aforesaid fact and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

The present case being relating to recovery of non commercial quantity of contraband rigors of Section 37 of NDPS Act are not applicable to the instant case. Further the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail 05.08.2022 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the condition envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
