Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the essential qualification number (ii) for the post of Dietician published at Sr. No.8 of the Advt. No.11(i)/2016 dated 18.11.2016 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that *qua* aforesaid grievance, petitioner also caused issuance of a representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned state counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law. While deciding the said representation, petitioner be also given an opportunity of personal hearing.

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
