The prayer in the petition is for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondent nos.2 to 4 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide them and their family members appropriate security as the respondent nos.5 to 29 had earlier illegally detained the petitioner no.2, the minor son of the petitioner no.1, with intention to take him from her lawful custody forcefully and to take illegal and forcible possession of the property of the petitioner no.1.

Notice of motion had been issued in this petition vide order dated 15.09.2021, pursuant to which the State has filed reply dated 18.01.2022. As per the said reply, the petitioner had moved an application dated 02.09.2021 to SSP Ludhiana (Rural) praying for protection which was marked to the SHO for enquiry. The petitioner was summoned by the

enquiry officer and gave a statement that she had filed the instant writ petition in this Court and that she would abide by the decision of this Court. She prayed that her applications may be filed. She also stated that if any necessity arises in future, she would again submit such application for protection to the police. Her statement is attached as Annexure R-3.

The SHO submitted his enquiry report and recommended to file the application of the petitioner vide report dated 06.11.2021 which was endorsed by the DSP Raikot and SSP, Ludhiana Rural has approved this enquiry report vide order dated 01.12.2021. The applications of the petitioner had therefore been filed.

A perusal of the reply would show that the petitioner does not want to take any action to be taken by the police on her application at this juncture.

If at any stage, the petitioner has apprehension as has been set out in the present petition, she is at liberty to move a fresh application and if the same is moved, the official respondents shall take appropriate action if found necessary.
