Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.675 dated 14.7.2022 registered under Sections 306 IPC at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

As per allegations in the FIR, Pawan husband of the complainant committed suicide as he was persistently harassed by the present petitioner who is stated to be having illicit relations with the deceased.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case at the instance of the complainant and all the allegations levelled by the complainant against the petitioner are false. He further submits that no suicide note was left behind by the deceased and that the petitioner has already joined the investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail dated 5.8.2022.

State counsel on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar has not

refuted the fact that Pawan husband of the complainant committed suicide but no suicide note was recovered in the present case. He has admitted the fact that the petitioner joined the investigation with the police and is not required for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

It is a matter of evidence as to whether the petitioner was having any relationship with the deceased and further, as to whether she was persistently harassing and compelled the deceased to end his life by committing suicide.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 5.8.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
