AMARJOT BHATTI J. (ORAL)

The petitioner-Vishkaramjot Singh @ Jota has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing cross version GD No.027 dated 28.09.2019, registered under Section 354-A of IPC recorded in FIR No.81 dated 03.05.2019, registered under Sections 323, 325 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Division 'B' Amritsar, District Amritsar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise between the parties.

As per the facts of the case, the complainant-Jaspreet Kaur gave her statement to the police that she is a house wife and got married with Sandeep Singh about eight years ago. Before her marriage, her

in-laws and family of respondent No.2 were on visiting terms with each other. Since the last year Vishkaramjot Singh @ Jota behaved in a wrongful manner with her and this fact was disclosed by her to her mother-in-law Gurmeet Kaur. Thereafter, they started avoiding each other. Vishkaramjot Singh @ Jota behaved in an indecent manner whenever she went to the roof top or to the market. He started stalking her. Her mother-in-law tried to make him understand, but he did not listen. On 05.04.2019 at about 8:00 PM he had a scuffle with her father-in-law Bawa Singh. With these allegations the cross version G.D. was registered.

The petitioner filed this petition for the quashing of aforesaid cross version G.D. No.27 dated 28.09.2019 on the basis of compromise. The petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. The detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the the court of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar dated 10.11.2022. The statement of complainant-Jaspreet Kaur has been recorded, where she confirmed the compromise with the petitioner. She confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and she has no objection regarding quashing of cross version.

The petitioner-Vishkaramjot Singh @ Jota also confirmed this fact in his separate statement. The statement of SI Davinder Singh is also recorded who further confirmed that the accused is neither involved in any other case nor has been declared as proclaimed

offender.

Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar, it is clear that the compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. It was a case of version and cross version. They have mutually settled all their disputes. Now they will be able to live peacefully as they are living in the same locality. Therefore, no purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

Therefore considering these facts the petition filed by the petitioner is accepted and cross version GD No.027 dated 28.09.2019, registered under Section 354-A of IPC recorded in the FIR No.81 dated 03.05.2019, registered under Sections 323, 325 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Division 'B' Amritsar, District Amritsar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
