The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 23.02.2022 (Annexure P-9), whereby the petitioners have been directed to make the payments to respondent No. 2, being consumer.

It is not even in dispute that the order impugned in the present writ petition is appealable under the statutory provisions.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere, at this stage.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail his statutory remedy of appeal, but in accordance with law.
