[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 12.05.2022, in CWP No.10084 of 2022 in case titled as '**Geeta versus Haryana Staff Selection Commission and another**'.

[2] Perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.10084 of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 12.05.2022 by directing the respondents to look into representation dated 25.04.2022 filed by the petitioner and to pass an administrative order in respect thereto, in accordance with law, within four weeks.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 18.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 18.08.2022 by way of appropriate

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
