[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.05.2022, in CWP No.12294 of 2022 in case titled as '**M/s B.S. Builders** versus **The State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.12294 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide legal notice dated 07.05.2022 in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the claim of the petitioner was established to release payment to the petitioner forthwith.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel contends that pursuant to issuance of notice to respondent No.4, claim of the petitioner has been decided and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested

in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
