[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners frankly concedes that he is seeking compliance of order dated 17.10.1996 in CWP No.11874 of 1995 whereas perusal of the instant petition reveals that action is sought against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 23.12.2016 in CWP No.16191 of 1997 in case titled as '**Jagtar Singh and others**versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] Learned counsel further concedes that the petitioners (herein) were not petitioners in CWP No.16191 of 1997 in case titled as '**Jagtar Singh and others**versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[3] Faced with the query with regard to maintainability of the instant petition in the light of relief claimed being *qua* order dated 17.10.1996 in CWP No.11874 of 1995, learned counsel prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
