In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for the grant of pension after computing the service, which he had rendered from the year 1987 to 1989.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State raises a preliminary objection that the claim of the petitioner is against respondent No.2 i.e. Governing body of the S.D. College, Panipat, District Panipat hence, the present petition is not maintainable before this Court and the petitioner has to avail a remedy before the Educational Tribunal, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the objection raised by the learned State counsel, the petitioner be relegated to avail an appropriate remedy before the Educational Tribunal, Panipat but, prays that as the pleadings in the present petition are almost complete, the

paperbook of the present case be sent to the Educational Tribunal, Panipat for passing an appropriate order otherwise precious time of the Educational Tribunal will be consumed in completing the pleadings, which are already completed in the present case before this Court.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for the said proposal of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

As prayed for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is relegated to avail an appropriate remedy before the Educational Tribunal, Panipat.

Let the complete paperbook of the present petition be sent to the Educational Tribunal, Panipat.

Parties are directed to appear before the Educational Tribunal, Panipat on 11.10.2022.
