In the present petition, the claim of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the regularization for their services with effect from the date their juniors have been regularized. In the present case, the petitioners's services were regularised in the year 2017 whereas, it is submitted that the juniors of the petitioners have been regularised with effect from 09.08.2014 and hence, the petitioners are also entitled for the same relief.

After notice of motion, respondents have filed the reply wherein the claim of the petitioners has been conceded by the respondents in paragraph 4, in paragraph 5 of the reply it has been mentioned that the appropriate order granting the petitioners necessary relief has already been passed on 19.11.2019, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure R-1.

Keeping in view the said fact, once the relief, prayed in the present petition has already been extended to the present petitioners, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
