VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is the first petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing the FIR bearing No.91 dated 02.06.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

It has been pointed out by learned State counsel that there are another five accused persons who have not been impleaded as party in the present case and have not appeared before the trial Court to record their statements in support of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, in view of the same, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after the impleading all the concerned persons as party and after the parties are ready

to give statements in respect of compromise before the trial Court.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Pending miscellaneous application stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
