1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.03.2019, in CWP-8099-2018, in case titled as Ramesh Chand vs. State of Punjab and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 11.03.2019, reveals that CWP-8099-2018, was allowed and respondent No.3 was directed to calculate interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed payment which was made to the petitioner and to release the same to the petitioner.

3. Today, none is present on behalf of the petitioner. However, as per reply dated 14.01.2021, a sum of Rs.1,46,084/- on account of interest @ 9% per annum from the date the petitioner became entitled to till date of actual payment of pensionary benefits, has been released to the petitioner vide cheque No.819013 dated 16.12.2020.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, states that in the circumstances, the instant petition may be disposed of as not calling for any action against

5. None is present on behalf of the petitioner. Even for that matter none was present on behalf of the petitioner on 18.01.2021.

6. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned AAG, Punjab, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the instant petition if cause subsists.
