Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.514 dated 28.7.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 420, 406, 34 IPC (sections 376(2)(N), 376-D and 506 IPC were added later on) at Police Station, Hansi City, District Hisar.

By virtue of the order dated 15.9.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 15.9.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same. However, he submits that some of the dowry articles are yet to be recovered.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
