The instant writ petition had been filed in 2017 to quash the action of the respondents whereby the petitioner has been kept under suspension beyond the period of more than four months without any charge-sheet having been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would submit that by an order dated 19.07.2017, the suspension order had been ordered to be kept in abeyance. The petitioner stands exonerated by an order dated 24.10.2017 and the suspension period stands regularized vide the same order. He would very fairly submits that in view of the said development and orders passed vide Annexure R-1, he does not press the instant petition as the same stands rendered infructuous.
