HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.92 dated 11.02.2022, registered at Police Station Bhiwani City, Bhiwani, under Sections 323, 324 and 506 IPC and Section 326 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case; that injuries attributed to the petitioner are on the non-vital parts of complainant-Surender and his wife-Sudesh; that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.04.2022 and that the challan has already been presented. On this premise, learned counsel prays for the grant of bail to the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, while opposing the grant of bail to the petitioner, submits that the petitioner had caused injuries on the hands of the complainant and also on the person of his wife-Sudesh.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The injuries attributed to the petitioner are on the non-vital parts of complainant-Surender and his wife-Sudesh. The charges have already been framed. The petitioner has been in custody since 19.04.2022.

The prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined. Trial is unlikely to conclude any time soon. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
