Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the respondents to update the status of Government Primary School, Indergarhi, which has been reflected in Zone-5 and not in Zone-3.

The following order was passed on 23.03.2022:-

Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the respondents to update the status of Government Primary School, Indergarhi, which has been reflected in Zone-5 and not in Zone-3.

Notice of motion in this writ petition was issued on 14.11.2017 and in the meantime, the petitioner, it was directed, was entitled to continue at Government Primary School, Mugal Pura.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to order dated 18.12.2017, Annexure R1, which has been passed pursuant to order dated 14.11.2017, submits that both the

schools i.e., GPS Indergarhi and GPS Vishavkarma Colony fall in Zone-3.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 06.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner be notified of the date fixed. In case there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing, this writ petition may be dismissed in default.”

Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed in default.
