In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that they have not completed minimum five years of service at a particular station so as to force them to participate in the transfer drive.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that cut of date for counting the time period, as mentioned in transfer policy, is 31.03.2022 and upto the said date, the petitioners have not completed the required five years service.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the cut of date, as being contended by the petitioners i.e. 31.03.2022, has already been

amended keeping in view the delay in implementation of the transfer policy and now the cut of date has been fixed as 31.08.2022 so as to compute the required period of five years and upto 31.08.2022, petitioners do complete the required period of five years so as to compulsorily participate in the transfer policy.

Keeping in view the above, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and no order is required to be passed in this petition.

It is made clear that in case the petitioners have any other grievance with regard to the participation in the transfer policy, the petitioners will be free to approach the respondents for the redressal of the same.

The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
