1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.05.2022, in CWP-9353-2022.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-9353-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 25.03.2022, by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any relief, to extend the same to the petitioner within the next four weeks.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply on behalf of respondent No.2 along with copy of speaking order dated 24.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner, as contained in legal notice dated 25.03.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that he has

instructions from the petitioner to state that in the circumstances, the

petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 24.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
