Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.298 dated 08.08.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at P.S Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise deed dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Upon notice, reply filed by way of affidavit dated 06.11.2022 of Sh. Jai Singh, DSP Ladwa, Kurukshetra, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, in Court today is taken on record.

Vide order dated 06.08.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilaqa Magistrate on 05.09.2022 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 29.09.2022 of learned JMIC, Kurukshetra has

been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.298 dated 08.08.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at P.S Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
