State counsel submitted that out of total 23 witnesses, the prosecution has already examined 21 witnesses including the complainant. She further submitted that as the trial is at its fag end, the present petition be disposed of accordingly. However, counsel for the petitioner further submitted that presently one application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to summon one another person as an additional accused is pending before the trial Court and it will take time for final disposal of the case due to pendency of the said application .

Counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the petitioner is behind bars for the last about 2½ years.

Taking into consideration, the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within next 6 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
