JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 15.07.2022 registered at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa, under Section 420 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 05.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated the Investigating Officer. He further submits that parties have compromised the matter and a quashing petition in this regard has already been filed in this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Teja Singh does not dispute the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner and further submits that petitioner has joined investigation and custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.08.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.
