Allegedly, a street vendor is blocking the entrance to the shop of the petitioner by parking his handcart. On a complaint filed before the Municipal Corporation the authorities removed the handcart but the private respondent has come back. Allegedly, he has support of the local MLA and, thus, legal notice dated 01.07.2022 (Annexure P-9) has been issued demanding the removal of the handcart as the same amounts to encroachment upon the public street. No action has, however, been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Arun K. Kaundal, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf respondents No. 1 and 4 and waives service. At the asking of the Court, he accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 as well and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file reply.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 01.07.2022 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
