The instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Nos.1 to 4 to implement order dated 03.10.2005 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 15.05.2017 (Annexure P-9) in view of the medical record (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and further to issue directions to respondent Nos.3 to 4 to allocate light work/duty to the petitioner in view of the medical record and not to allocate him hard night duty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner was suffering from mental illness, which necessitated the petitioner to be put to light duty. It is contended that wife of the petitioner herein approached the authorities concerned stating that her husband was mentally unwell and was unable to perform any hard tasks. It is submitted that as per the

reply filed, as on date, the petitioner has been put on light dak duty and, therefore, he would not press the instant writ petition with liberty to approach the Court again, should the need so arises.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty aforesaid.
