Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.133 dated 04.07.2021 under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 506 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Women NIT, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of order dated 16.9.2021 the petitioner had joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She submits that false allegations have been levelled against the petitioner of subjecting the complainant to mental and physical harassment on account of dowry demands. Learned counsel further submits that in fact it was due to temperamental differences that complainant was unable to adjust in the

matrimonial home as a result of which she planted a false case upon the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sonika has not disputed the factum of petitioner having joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further on instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation muchless for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 16.9.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
