The prayer of the petitioners in the present petition is for the grant of of ACP Scheme on completion of service of 4, 9 and 14 years as per the policy issued by Government of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the order passed by this Court on 13.01.2020, claim of the petitioner was re-considered by the Department and an order dated 04.06.2020 was passed by it, whereby petitioner No.3 has been found entitled for the grant of benefit and the same has been released in his favour, whereas petitioner No.1, 2 and 4 have not been found eligible for the grant of said benefits as they never opted

for the benefits within the time allotted and their cases have been rejected by the respondents vide the order dated 04.06.2020, hence keeping in view the above mentioned facts, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner Nos.1, 2 and 4 are aggrieved with the order dated 04.06.2020, they will be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy for the redressal of their grievances before an appropriate Forum.
