Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to complete the investigation and present a '*challan*' in FIR bearing no. 09 of 07.03.2019, registered at Police Station NRI Wing, Mataur, Mohali, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/420/120-B of the IPC.

The affidavit dated 02.12.2021 filed by DSP, N.R.I, Wing, S.A.S. Nagar, is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the reply, though one of the accused, i.e. Ranjit Singh, could not be arrested despite best efforts (as contended), proceedings under the provisions of Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. have been initiated against him and as regards the other accused, Baljit Singh, the report under the provision of Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted to the competent court on 25.11.2021.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press this petition.

Obviously he would have the liberty to take his remedy qua any grievance that he has, before the competent court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty always available with him.
