Through this 2nd petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 103 dated 12.10.2015, registered under Sections 302, 307 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on 12.10.2015 and the petitioner has been in custody since 12.10.2015. He restricts his prayer to the extent of issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a stipulate period.

Learned State counsel submits that out 29 prosecution witnesses, 19 have been examined and the next date before the learned trial Court is 16.08.2022. He also points out that out of 10 remaining prosecution witnesses, two Doctors are the material one.

Keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court, to make an endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of six months.
