As per allegations in the petition, petitioner No.2 is already married with respondent No.4 but they are having strained relations and as such, now petitioner No.2 is into live-in-relationship with petitioner No.1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 to 9 are against the aforesaid relationship of the petitioners and are extending threats to them and in this context, representation dated 1.8.2022 (Annexure P-1) has already been given to the police authorities but no action has been taken on it till date.

Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the aforesaid representation.

Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance

with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Palwal to consider representation dated 1.8.2022 (Annexure P-1) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 9 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
