Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to grant the parity in re-revision of pay-scales to petitioners at par with the Pharmacists working in other department(s).

Paper-book reveals that although, petitioners had approached the respondents for redressal of their grievance, vide representations dated 20.04.2012 (P-11) & 23.08.2012 (P-12), but till date no final decision has been taken in the matter.

Prima facie, it seems to be a grave lapse on the part of the respondents while not deciding the aforesaid representations in accordance with law.

Be that as it may, without going into the merits of the

controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Principal Secretary, Department of Finance, Punjab, to consider the grievance of petitioners in accordance with law, by passing reasoned order within a period of 03 (three) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
