The petitioner is a research scholar and is pursuing her Ph.D History Course in the Panjab University. She joined the course sometime in the year 2012 and was required to complete it within eight years. Allegedly, on account of Covid-19 pandemic, she could not complete the same within time and extension has been granted to her. However, *bona fide* student certificate has not been issued by the Panjab University. She is also not being permitted to reside in the hostel on account of non-clearance of dues. Communication dated 08.04.2022 has been sent by the Iranian Embassy recommending her case, yet, the necessary relief has not been granted.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with a request to the Vice Chancellor of the Panjab University to consider the recommendation dated 18.04.2022 made by the Iranian Embassy sympathetically and pass an order within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
