Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the respondents to restore the annual increments along with other service benefits of the petitioner by granting him exemption in respect of Condition No.6 in his appointment letter for qualifying the Type Test of Punjabi. Further prayer is for allowing the petitioner to acquire Computer Type Training from the Department of Information Technology or any other Agency in terms of Government Instructions dated 23.12.2011 (P-2).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 26.08.2018 (P-8) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 26.08.2018 (P-8) as per law within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
