By this petition, quashing of FIR No.438, dated 08.07.2019, is sought, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak, for the alleged commission of the offences punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.09.2021, the report of the learned

JMIC, Rohtak, dated 18.10.2021, has been received, stating to the effect that the complainant-respondent no.2, Neha Goyal, appeared before that court as did the petitioner, Arpit Garg, with them submitting that they had settled the matter with each other (being husband and wife), and have no grievance left.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and the said respondent submit that they have even been granted a decree of divorce.

As per the assessment of the learned JMIC, the matter was compromised between the parties of their own free will.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.438, dated 08.07.2019, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
